

Privacy Notice

This policy statement is designed to give a clear explanation of Clesse UK's data processing practices. Clesse UK will be the data controller of any personal data that you submit when you register as a customer or place a direct order. Clesse (UK) Limited is registered with the Information Commissioner as a data controller under registration number ZA328109.

What information do we collect from you?

As a supplier, Clesse UK needs to keep and process information about you. The information we hold and process will be used for management and administrative use only. We will keep and use it to:

- enable us to run the business and manage our relationship with you effectively, lawfully and appropriately
 - during the sales process;
 - whilst we are supplying or procuring goods;
 - at the time when business stops and after your account has been closed.

This includes using information to enable us to comply with any legal requirements, pursue the legitimate interests of the Company and protect our legal position in the event of legal proceedings.

If you do not provide this data, we may be unable in some circumstances to comply with our obligations and provide you with an appropriate level of service.

Information you give us

This is information about you that you give us by filling in forms on our site www.clesse.co.uk (our site), live-chat or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. The information you give us may include:

- Personally identifiable information about you, such as your name, address, company, telephone/fax number, your email address, purchasing, credit or debit card details (where relevant) and delivery address;
- Non-Personally identifiable information such as anonymous usage data, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform types, number of clicks etc to help us understand marketing patterns, product interest and to optimize our website for a better experience. Non-personally identifiable information may be stored indefinitely.



Call Recording

Telephone calls are recorded or monitored, for example calls to our sales or technical team. Call recording and monitoring may be carried out for the following purposes:

- training and quality control;
- as evidence of conversations.

Why do we collect this information?

We use the information that you give to us in the following ways:

- Internal record keeping;
- For registration purposes and to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;
- We may use the information to improve our products, services and to provide product support;
- We may periodically send promotional emails about new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided;
- To grow our business and to keep customers informed enabling them to grow their business by providing better solutions;
- To notify you about changes to our service;
- To improve products and services on our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

Who might we share your information with?

We will only disclose information about you to third parties if we are legally obliged to do so or where we need to comply with our contractual duties to you, for instance we may need to pass on certain information (address, contact details) to our contracted couriers to deliver a service.

Storage and protection of your data.

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect. The servers and cloud storage that we use to store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

How long do we keep hold of the information?

Business to business (Including personally identifiable data) – 7 years from last sales transaction

Business to consumer (Including personally identifiable data) – 7 years from last sales transaction

Non-Personally identifiable data – Indefinitely

If in the future we intend to process your personal data for a purpose other than that which it was collected for we will provide you with information on that purpose and any other relevant information, including the opportunity to opt in. Cookies

An HTTP cookie (also called web cookie, Internet cookie, browser cookie, or simply cookie) is a small piece of data sent from a website and stored on the user's computer by the user's web browser while the user is browsing.
